



# CALL for Thematic Sessions

The IEEE MetroXRINE 2025 Organizing Committee invites proposals for Thematic Sessions on new or emerging topics in metrology for extended reality, artificial intelligence, and/or neural engineering that have the potential to have a major impact on the field in the near future.

The goal of these thematic sessions is to provide a forum for focused discussions on new topics or innovative applications of established approaches. A thematic session could address a particular theme or consist of work done in some particular international project.

## THEMATIC SESSION PROPOSALS

Thematic Session **proposals** must contain the following information:

- Title of the proposed Thematic Session;
- Names, affiliations, and contact information of the session organizers;
- Brief biographies of the session organizers;
- Brief description of the proposed session with a list of the related topics.

Papers submitted to thematic sessions will undergo the same review process as regular papers, where the Thematic Session Organizers are responsible for organizing the peer-review process.
